## Kosovo—PPPs

#### Summary of PPP portfolio

- ▶ 18 project in different stages
- ▶ Many project don't reach financial close
- ▶ Magnitude in % GDP by economic sector
  - ◆ Around 1.5% of GDP with current PPPs in implementation
  - ◆ Could reach 17-20% with new Power Plant BOT
  - ◆ Transport, Prishtina Airport ~120 mil.\$
  - ◆ Urban Development, Underground Parking, 15mil \$
  - ◆ Turisim, CP completion phase, 62mil \$

#### ► Characteristics of main projects

- ◆ Mainly concessions
- Municipality of Prishtina working on first govt. funded project in education (4 primary education schools)

## **Kosovo—PPPs continued**

- Issues, challenges, recommendation of recent IMF TA, progress so far
  - ► PIMA 2016 and consecutive follow-ups
    - Increase transparency of budget documentation by including an annex for PPP and POE investments, and a statement of contingent liabilities.
    - ◆ The PPP Law gives the MoF a strong role in managing the potential fiscal costs and risks arising from investment projects procured as PPPs
    - ◆ The fiscal costs and fiscal risks associated with PPPs are neither systematically assessed nor reported
    - Current arrangements for the accounting and reporting of PPPs do not conform to good practice

# **Kosovo—Reporting PPPs**

#### Legal framework

- ► Value for money
- ► Affordability
- ▶ All PPPs have to submit annual reports to the PPPC, but these reports include only limited information on fiscal risks.

#### Reporting of PPPs

#### Currently

- ► There was no progress on PIMA's recommendation to include an annex to the budget for PPPs and POE investments until recently
- Administrative Instruction mf- no. 06/2019 on selection criteria and prioritizing of capital projects
- ► PFRAM for BOT in Energy
- ▶ Fiscal risk and contingent liabilities to be introduced in the new PPP law

# **Kosovo—Reporting PPPs**

- PPPs outside the central and general government
  - ► Energy sector, large BOT project,
    - ◆ PFRAM
  - ► Final Condition Precedent from Gvt. side to be addressed for new PP project
    - ◆ Sovereign guarantee
